Featured Speaker: Steve Saari

The February luncheon speaker is Steve Saari. Steve is the, Interim Chief, Watershed Protection Division, Planning and Restoration Branch, District Department of Energy & Environment (DOEE) for the DC Government. Steve has overseen a wide range of projects at DDOE. These include incentivizing homeowners to upgrade landscaping for improved drainage; stream restoration within the Rock Creek watershed; drafting an urban tree canopy plan for the District; writing DOEE’s Watershed Implementation Plan for Rock Creek; and co-authoring the District’s plan to restore its portion of the Anacostia River. His work has included installation of low impact development techniques that use stream restoration methods to slow storm water velocities, infiltrate storm water, recharge groundwater, and treat pollutants through chemical and biological processes. Steve has a M.S. in ecology from Pennsylvania State University and has been in the watershed restoration field for seventeen years.
